



# REAR MOUNTED INJECTOR



**Shown Above is the Optional coversups on 2 teeth**

4 Tooth with spring teeth and spring assemblies, Optional extra teeth up to 7

Teeth are clamped on with U bolted assy for ease of sliding and adjustment

10 foot tool bar on smaller spreaders with 21.5L x 16.1 tires, 12 foot tool bar on spreaders with 28L x 26

12" sweeps standard, 2" chisels optional

Parallel link bar lift assy with hardened wear bushings at all wear joints, phasing cylinders for even lift

4 hole to 7 hole canister with outlets all on one level

6" line into the canister , optional 8" inlet

3" hose lines to the Injector teeth

Top spread of liquid with a few moments change over ( no wrenches required)

Large gauge wheels are mounted on tubing that is U bolted to the main tool bar by U bolts

Gross Weight 2000 pounds for the Rear injector 4 tooth

## **Optional**

Disc covers to put manure on the ground and cover the soil over them

Disc covers for the side of the rear injector to cover in the soil

Aerways to pull or mount behind spreader for No Till ground

Drop spouts to put manure between corn rows

Boom to spread manure even at 18" above ground

Bourgault or Yetter injector mounted on Husky tool bar

Konskilde teeth mounted on Husky tool bar

3 point hitch available for any Husky Spreader
